Privacy Rights

The Peninsula Newcomers' Club is committed to the protection of privacy rights in accordance with BC's Personal Information Protection Act (PIPA). Towards this end, the club collects and disseminates personal information solely for the purpose of carrying out the mandate and activities of the organization.

Information Collected

The club collects the following personal information for all its members:

- Member's name, and name of partner
- Year of membership
- Home address
- Home phone number
- Email address

Purposes of Information

The information is used to develop a membership list for the exclusive use of the club's members. The membership list is updated and printed in hard copy (or emailed to members) every month from September until June of the following year.

Information in relation to new members who join the club in the course of a year may also be printed in the club's monthly newsletter.

Consent

Information is provided at the discretion of each club member. In signing up for membership, all new members are given the option of not having their personal information included in the membership list and/or the monthly newsletter.

Limits on the Use of Information

The membership list is developed for the exclusive use of the club's members. This list is neither sold nor shared with other organizations. The monthly newsletter is circulated among club members only. Personal information is used solely for the club's purposes and any other use is expressly forbidden.

Privacy Officer

The membership coordinator of the club is also the privacy officer responsible for dealing with members' complaints or inquiries and ensuring compliance with PIPA.
